The programme and work experience will be offered in Johannesburg and Cape Town over a 15-month period at a competitive salary under the auspices of the ASISA Academy on behalf of the participating employers.

Participating Investment Management businesses will host graduates at their offices and provide workplace experience to build the knowledge, experience and professional skills for a strong foundation and career in the industry. Graduates successfully completing the programme will be certificated as Financial Market Practitioners, be ready to write their CFA level 1 exam and have built valuable experience and networks with leading asset management businesses and potential employers.

- Qualifying criteria: focus will be on recruiting students that show an aptitude for finance, staying power, application and a spirit of volunteerism
- Assessments will then validate those with high potential to succeed in our industry and support final selection for the programme
